Did you know that you can use w3dview to view "pure animation" files? For example to view a weapon hand position animation like f_ha_rifl_reload.w3d (the reload hand animation for the rifle), extract one of the hands (f_hm_gdi,f_hm_nod or f_hm_havoc plus the 2 texture files for it. Also extract the hand position animation(s) that you want to view. You also need the f_skelleton.w3d file extracted. Then, open the hands in w3dview. Then go to file-open and open the animation file. You can then view it. The same thing works with body and face animations, make sure you extract the relavent skelleton for whatever it is you are using.
