Swapping power supplies is a bit more difficult than swapping video cards, but from what I've been told it isn't very hard to do. When I got a new video card (from Geforce 4 MX 440 64 MB to a ATI Radeon 9600 Pro 128 MB) my system suffered from spontaneous reboots, mostly when playing heavy games like Splinter Cell: PT or UT2K4. I was convinced my 250W power supply couldn't handle my system anymore after the videocard upgrade, but after a week or so the spontaneous reboots stopped. To this day I still don't know what caused them (I was and am virus- and spywarefree), but the bright side was I didn't need to upgrade my power supply
