Oh God. The stench of retardation here is horrible.

Yes, they most likely do need to have different CD keys. And don't use CD key generators: they are illegal.

I would venture a guess that a lot of the drivers for Windows XP are incompatible with Windows 98SE (ever wondered why most drivers have separate installers for Windows XP and Windows 98SE?). Do not copy your XP stuff to 98SE.

That's fine that your connection is set up only via a single ethernet cord between the two computers. As long as each computer has a different IP address, that should work well (and, since your desktop computer can \*see\* the game, it indicates that they \*DO\* have different IP addresses).

You may need the Win98SE CD because when you alter your TCP/IP settings for Win98SE, it typically asks you to insert your Win98SE CD into your CD-ROM drive. If it does not, then you're lucky and do not need it. Do not insert your Windows XP CD into your Windows 98SE machine for \*any\* reason except to upgrade to Windows XP (that is, do NOT install XP drivers from the XP CD into a Windows 98SE installation!!)
