As always, it's up to you to decide whether or not to install RenGuard on your machine.

Remember that if you don't install RenGuard, you are more prone to being accused of cheating because anyone can cheat quite easily without RenGuard. But that's beside the point... you're questioning the credibility of BlackHand Studios. I am unfamiliar with every working aspect of BlackHand Studios, so I cannot comment on that. However, I can assure you that RenGuard, a product of BlackHand Studios, does not transmit anything beyond what is necessary to satisfy two things:

- 1) Verify you are not using known (or possibly unknown) cheats
- 2) Provide unique information required to prevent you from connecting if you abuse RenGuard

If you have any specific questions regarding credibility, then please ask. I feel that there are a lot of people that unjustly doubt the "true" purpose of RenGuard, and I hope to be able to help solve that problem.
