A couple of hours testing this and that and I have figured out what is causing the Buffer Over run in my case

MULTIPLE FIREWALLS

I am willing to bet somewhere between your system and your hardware you have multiple firewalls causing a conflict between firewalls or proxy's. Most routers have firewalls and when you adapt one to your system this cause a conflict between the two giving you a buffer overrun.

This fixed the issue somewhat for my system. I removed my system firewall and hacked the reg keys to make sure and I no longer have the Buffer Overrun error. The trick would be able to allow all Renguard process to pass your firewall and then dmz zone the system theoretically and it should work as well.

Havent tried that one yet, will get back to you after I have logged all the processes for Renguard and then set the firewall up to see what happens
