There are other, secretive, ways of having additional radio commands that are not as lame as objects.ddb. In particular, you can tell whether or not someone has used an objects.ddb file by asking them to go through all of their radio commands. If they still have all 30 of their old radio commands, then they are in fact not using objects.ddb and are thus unlikely to have damage or rate-of-fire modifications.

That is true, however, if someone who is highly trusted within this community to make these radio mods (or those without any knowlage on how to edit weapon ROF etc etc) they may not contain anything that will give them an unfair advantage.
