This letter is addressed to the related users of the case of me using RGH, the n00bstories staff team and to the close online friends.

I would like to take this opportunity and extend my apologies to the staff of n00bstories and to the server owner, Crimson. Most importantly, to the community for the use of *cheat name removed* on the server, n00bstories AOW/CMM 1. I would also like to apologize for the disappointment if any of you had for me.

I am not a malicious person. Some of the few long-term players like Amber, [BA]Achilles, babyfire4 (both the account owner and his girlfriend, though I hardly see them recently) and some others, know me better than the other regulars.
