Then boot to it, and when you reach the console, type

```
fdisk -l
```

to determine what device you have, then do:

```
dd if=/dev/zero of=/dev/(the device) bs=4096
```

Alternatively, you could do:

```
mkdir /mnt/ntfsmnt  
ntfs-3g /dev/(the device) /mnt/ntfsmnt  
rm -rf /mnt/ntfsmnt
```
