R315r4z0r wrote on Sun, 11 May 2008 06:46: What I do is use this program called WinAVI and convert the FRAPs recording into some other file. WMV usually gets pretty small.

And if you are only looking for another way of recording just because the file sizes are too big, then you are out of luck because all recording programs record like that. (Unless they have some sort of video converter built in... but I don't know what's out there.)

This is true you can get recording programs like this that will record and encode on the go however... Trying to play a game, record and then encode at the same time isn't going to give a good FPS ingame unless you have atleast a Duo/X2 cpu and you can set one CPU to game and the other to record/encode. Even then I still wouldn't recommend it.
