Not only has john attempted a "cease and desist", but he physically removed his template when he had the authority to do so. Putting the copyrighted material back up is copyright infringement.

Personally, if you make a design for a community you're a part of, the respectful thing is to just leave what you gave them and move on. However, that doesn't mean you're obligated to do that.

Regardless if BfD has their old template or not, they need to cease using john's template as he requested.
