If we're going to delve into technicalities, the number two doesn't mean the word "to" and therefore the acronym is FTP. Otherwise, you're saying Free Two Play. Like when someone says Got Two Go. It doesn't make sense.

RenX is a FTP game as far as I'm concerned. Freeware would be equally applicable, but the terms aren't mutually exclusive.

FTP may be what you like to call it, but the rest of the world uses the acronym F2P. It may not make sense, but that's the way it is.

Remember, "it's Nod, not NOD" and "it's texturing, not skinning"? Same type of deal here.

RenX also isn't a F2P game because the it has no micro-transactions.
