Note that there is another issue that sometimes causes the install to fail (see quote below). To fix your issue completely, download the RC2 installer from <http://tiberiantechologies.org/downloads> and then install the following two packages:

Quote:I have identified the issue and it will be fixed as soon as possible, hopefully in a few hours. I'll post in the release topic when it is fixed. Until then, you can fix the issue by installing the following packages manually if you have not already done so:

The RC2 installer erroneously attempts to install both at the same time, whereas only one simultaneous installation is allowed. That causes one of both installations to fail.
