flyingfoxThe longer dial pattern I can relate to. I used to have a 56k modem which would occasionally do the same thing. All I did was disconnect and re-try a few times and it would be back at 49,333.

This might seem like a dumb thing, but have you tried disconnecting right after connecting and trying again? Also, I'd check your modem properties in start > settings > dial-up networking > properties of your modem. Have a look around, there is an option somewhere to set the maximum speed of your modem. Something (or someone) could have changed that setting.

If this fails, I'd give your ISP a call.

I've done that re-try thing for about a week now with the same results but im getting the lower 24k or 26k more that the 40k. I checked out the properties and changed the speed on several ocasions but the same thing occurs, i also tried updating the driver (no updates). And about calling an ISP... well.... i have this pirated version of MSN that give me free internet... So its really imposible for me to really call. Im really screwed on the speed for now.
