First you declare- char loopcon = 'y'; -

Next you do this in your case statement.

while (loopcon  $== 'y' \parallel$  loopcon == 'Y') This one is true the first time.

after the loop you to this. cin >> loopcon; I don't know what this means, but I guess this changes the value of loopcon, wich makes it not anymore value 'y'

So when you go back to a new case. while (loopcon == 'y' || loopcon == 'Y'), will be false.

Make sure after the while loop, loopcon is again 'y'.
