Free program (I think). serials are easy to find if you get tired of the banners, or popups, or whatever annoying tactics they use to try and get you to buy it. Downloads will be slow (~300kb/sec) because of the way it has to negotiate a speed with the hosting server. \*Note: that is kb, not kB (yea, kilobits, the slow one). Have fun.
