I decided that I would try team speak. So, I installed my Sound Blaster Live economy card and yada yada yada . Long story short my fps at the idle was the same as my monitor refresh rate. Now with the sound card installed and my refresh rate at 85 hertz the fps at idle is anywhere from 500 - 600. In game fps, I have seen over 100.
