Renegade Alert comes in a .exe installer, and the mod is in .mix format, and is installed to its own folder separate from the Renegade folder (C:\Westwood\RenAlert). The mod hasn't been in the .pkg format in a .zip for many releases.

You need to go here: http://dynamic.gamespy.com/~renalert/content/old/downloads_patches.php and download either the .993 full installer, or the .991 installer and each patch up to .993 and install them in order.
