I've seen a Renegade CD break it hapens more then you think. If I were you I would try do it in this steps.

1# uninnstal Renguard or whats left of it2# uninnstal Renegade3# Delete all remaining folders C:/Ren directory4# go to CMD typ regedit or just run > regedit.

Search for Renegade & Westwood Delete all keys.

Reboot.

Go to taskmanager and delete all unnecesary processes.

Put in the Renegade CD, Install. Have the 10 37 patch ready on your desktop before all of this. Install the patch. Try to run it now with CD first. If that doesnt work Install DJlaptops NOCD. which can be found at www.beaconpedestal.com/nocd

If this all doesnt work, a other program or whatever you did is messing up Renegade or is conflicting with Renegade. Reinstall windows imo.

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
