I am (was) a computer tech, so I'm comfortable working with anything in and out of the case, so if there are suggestions that would otherwise normally stop the faint of heart feel free to make them. I'm fine making the judgement on whether it's a stupid idea or not. I've reinstalled Win at least 3 times since the first time this has happened, and I just reinstalled 2 weeks ago, so I have a clean PC right now. I have SP2, all Windows patches.
