However, if and when they leave the team to stand on its own, I don't see Reborn lasting for much longer afterward. Why, you might ask? Simply because Renardin is still on the team. Granted, he's their only texture artist for the time being, so he's essential as of now, but if they get another equally talented texture artist, all he will do to the team is prevent it from reaching its full potential. Something tells me he won't stay in the "back seat" for long; hell, the whole time he's been the leader of Reborn, he always claimed he was "just a texture artist." If that was his idea of taking a back seat, his continued presence will only cause more harm than good. He's already received enough of a bad reputation from this whole debacle in successfully botching what could have been the best move the Reborn team could have made in its history. He showed he was completely unwilling to compromise and settle his differences with Aircraftkiller and whoever else on the RA:APB team at the time of the merger.
