Your firewall is blocking game2.exe because it changed (due to installing Renguard). Be sure game.exe and game2.exe are allowed to access the internet.

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Goztow is correct, don't listen to RenGod. If you can't play with Norton Anti-virus then you should get Avast or Anti-Virus Guard. Stop blaming Renguard for every little network issue. Just Press Alt + Tab to minimize the game(you may have to do it a few times before it realizes you are serious). This will most likely expose a windows security dialog box where you can allow Renguard to bypass your firewall. I'm thinking you have to allow both Renegade and Renguard to bypass the firewall, I may be mistaken. If it freezes again just a few seconds after returning to the game, you

should Alt + Tab back to desktop again, and repeat the above steps. Also, when you exit the game you may see the cursor moving under Renegade that seems to be frozen, hit Escape 3 or 4 times and it should close Renegade.
