To find the Renegade Configuration Tool go to your Renegade directory;

For gamers with TFD: C:\program files\lea games\Command & conquer The First Decade\Command & Conquer Renegade\.

For gamers with the normal Renegade: C:\westwood\renegade\.

In this directory there's a file called WWconfig.exe (this is the Renegade Configuration Tool), open it and from here on you can edit the resolution and other settings.
