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Our server for exemple asks a minimum BW of 105000. You only have 56k, so your BW will be set to the minimum of 105000 automatically. You will probably lag out then.

56k - players are always very laggy, especially on big servers. We don't want them, sorry. Stick to small servers which will not have this option enabled. The more players, the more bandwith vou need.
