Okay, so it's my understanding that all of you have an Athlon 64 with Windows XP (normal 32-bit edition). In addition, most (if not again, all?) have had RenGuard working previously. My guess is that Microsoft probably posted a patch for kernel32.dll recently which broke something. Without an Athlon 64 myself, it would be extremely difficult for me to track this down.

Something that could be done (it would most likely need to be done on a separate machine, or at least a separate Windows XP installation) would be to install the base Windows XP with Service Pack 2. Then install all of the updates until about two months ago. Then, add all updates since

then one by one until RenGuard no longer works. It may be ideal to focus on updates to kernel32.dll, but in fact it could be some other DLL raising an unhandled exception (kernel32!0x1eb33 is within kernel32.RaiseException()).

Again, I do not have an Athlon 64, so I cannot do this myself.
