The scripts are coded into the renegade_server binary. There is no scripts.so with the original LFDS from Westwood.

The scripts.so was made by jonwil. And we need a patch in order to load the scripts into the LFDS.

There is no renrem, with xwisp, it have provide an telnet interface for sending commands(not for getting output :/)

It is better to input console commands directly into the shell
