I had the same problem, and tried to follow the way you mentioned. After I deleted the WOLdata.key and changed the key, when I open game.exe (which is reanguard), it pop up saying hashing serial failed or something like that. However, when I try to use game2.exe (the original game.exe) it was able to pass through the XCC.

So what I turned out doing was to copy the WOLdata.key that was from my laptop (installed from the same DVD, with the same cdkey), and also changed the registry like you mentioned above, and problem solved:).

The strange thing is a few days ago when I was updating my reanguard on my laptop from 1.03 to 1.0322, nothing was wrong and I was able to play right after. Today I install a fresh new copy of TFD to my desktop and then upgrade to 1.02 TFD and afterwards the reanguard 1.0322. And this problem came up.

So to me it sounds like it is either the 1.02 TFD problem or the reanguard 1.0322 problem.

Hope you'll have that figured out so that I don't need to do this every single time.
