Also in the 'My Information' settings the Retest button simply sets the Connection to Auto(56700,56700) when it is clicked. I am using GSA and Scripts343 on ADSL.

I think those settings on "My Information" are for WOL(XWIS) so they wont have any effect on someone who is joining through Game Spy Arcade like me but its just a guess .

Isn't there anyway to turn on that bandwidth detector again when joining a server ? OR Could it be a Renguard issue because 90% of the time I get d/c is just before Renguard plays the sound "You have been connected to a Renguard Protected Server" ?
