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It means renegade is trying to set your bandwidth lower then the server owner would want on his server. I assume you're using WOL. Goto the login screen and move your mouse to the left, goto option/settings and somewhere in there should be an option for your bandwidth. It probably says its on 56k. Change this to T1/Lan. This will stop the messages and stop you from getting weird lag.

As for the serevr's "you never played in", I suggest you go there to test if it's any better. At least you'd know what the problem is.

Your problem could also be at your ISP, maybe it's overselling its capacity and you get a lot of packet loss. Or it could also be that you have an unsecured wireless network and neighbours are using it to download while you play. Or you have a brother that's using his computer to download on the same network while you're playing. Or maybe your router has a problem Or maybe...

There's a lot of things that could be wrong.

press F8,

then type "nur 30" <enter> (without the "")

That could help a bit, also, try playing on servers with NUR 30 on the serverside and in europe. I know for a fact that the BlackIntel server and TheKOSs2 server have these settings, so you could have a look to see if the lag is less there. If it is, then apparently the server where you

usually play on is either too far away (USA) or is badly configured.
