They liquidated the company since then. For online play, EA isn't much involved; they handed over control of the master servers to the Strike-Team with "XWIS". Basically, it's just WOL, but headed by a third party and it has some... quirks.

RenGuard was developed by Blackhand Studios, another third party. Unfortunately, RenGuard as is pretty crippled and considered useless by many. A new version is apparently in the works by Sir_Kane, someone as influential on Renegade as you remember Aircraftkiller to have been. Yes, RenGuard is the product of making Renegade a better experience; no compensation other than donations to Blackhand Studios is received.
