It takes them more time to destroy a tank than mobius or mendosa, but they can cover while reloading, and they can also kill infantry in one shot (they hate that!!!) mendosas and mobuis are excellent for defence because people usually concentrate on attacking the main target during a rush, hoping they'll destroy it (Flame rush is the best example, and the best way to stop one is by all being mobuis!)
