I've gotten used to using the RR launcher to play on servers, but some that host once in a blue moon don't show up due to the fact that RR uses an XML file with the server names and IP addresses rather than XWIS.

After installation, I tried accessing WOL. I received the invalid serial message, but I wasn't surprised knowing that sometimes it isn't encrypted properly after installation.

I then downloaded the serial-changer from the forums and set my serial again. To my dismay, I was still told that it was invalid. Luckily, I have two serials (I bought the game twice) and I had used my newer one.

Guess what happened when I tried my old serial.

This topic isn't a request for a crack, serial-gen or work-around, but rather I want to know if this is due to someone faking my serial and posting it online (and then XWIS banning it) or caused by a third-party ren-mod badly being installed (Reborn, R.S.S, RR etc).
