Sounds like the PS3 and the computer are both trying to use the same IP address. If your using DHCP you might want to increase the range of IP's the router can give out. Alternativly set static IP's (my preferred method for home networks) to ensure they are all unique. Also has the advantage of enabling you to forward ports to any machine on the network quickly and easily.

As for the PS3 itself, I intend to buy one eventually, if only to play FFXIII when it's released.
