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I'd really suggest reinstalling completely following the reinstall sticky. It seems you forgot to install patch 1.037 under the way... Installing it now will give you more errors on Renguard.

Also, Renguard is required on no more servers except n00bstories.

The 00000000005 error is usually related to not running the program in admin mode.
