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This has been happening to me for about 2 years now. You really just get used to it after a while.

I get a solid 60fps pretty much at all times except every 30-50 seconds, it will give a quick little jump or stutter. It's really fast, like .2-.5 seconds, but it's enough to get annoying if you're fighting someone.

This problem has also followed me into Reborn and APB. It also has been an issue over the use of three different graphics card upgrades.

And yes, the FPS does jump down, but it happens so quickly, that the counter doesn't accurately show the number. (I will be at 60, the frames will stutter, and it will say 40 and then 60 again)
