Just to add, I have tried the fix whereby I reinstall only westwood shared internet components off of my renegade disc. It does not seem to change anything, do I need to delete the ones from TFD or something?

Also I cannot open any of the files under c:\windows\system32\Drivers\etc\hosts as it says it 'is not a valid win32 application'

None of this happened before I installed the first decade though so Im assuming that has to be the link.

Must servers are also listed on GSA, you can use a small application called RenList to connect to GSA servers without have to install GameSpy Arcade. You can get it here:
