By default in Windows 8 the kernel state is saved to disk on shutdown and reloaded on the next boot to speed up loading times, but this could mean that whatever strange thing normally happens on a reboot to fix the menu text isn't happening due to the kernel not being reloaded from scratch.

If he is using Windows 8 you can test this theory by turning off hybrid boot and then restarting to force a full kernel reboot:

To confirm/bust this I tried it out on my system which hibernates the kernel state.

RESULT

Saving the kernel state does NOT block the issue from being solved with a restart.

A restart still fixes it even when saving the kernel state.

With other words, saving the kernel state or not has no influence.
