Renegade runs smoothly on an old P2-450 with an ATI Rage 128 that I have laying around, and the only difference between my two higher-end systems (the ones in my sig) in Renegade is that while running at the usual 1280x1024 with the highest settings, the newer system never moves from the standard 60 local FPS while my slightly older one occasionally drops to 58 local FPS in larger battles, etc.
