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You can get a fixed exe that will let you play without the CD. Just do a search on Google for: Renegade "no cd"

Remember to keep a copy of your original exe, otherwise you won't be able to patch the game and you'll be looking at a reinstall. This also applies to the exe after a patch, you'll need to then keep that one.

And remember, you're only allowed to use this if you've purchased an original copy of the game.
