Whenever I launch a game and it loads up, right when it starts I either have one or a mixture of the following:good fps missing textures such as water/radar/gunmodels, bad fps missing textures, or blue bars running across the screen every time I move. Also these problems persist whether everything is on high or low detail.

I can run high end games such as Halo PC (can set everything to high on SP without to much trouble), or play UTK4 fine....ect. My comp specs are: 2600+ athalon Gig of RAM 120 Gigs of memory, with 40 Gigs being used GeForce 5900 FX

So I'm not sure exactly what is going on, but I want the game since my clan is probably going to play/compete in it, I want to be sure that this won't happen with the full version of the game, and that it is only the demo that is messing up, and the full version won't....
