But I can't get it to fade out at this point. Would the audio its-self have to be edited before adding it to the mpeg encoder to create with the video? Winamp might be able to do something like that.

Also, how do you clip the edges, for example the top & bottom, to gradually shorten the view span into a cinema type screen at the end, as a sort of finish up thing? Any help would be appreciated.
